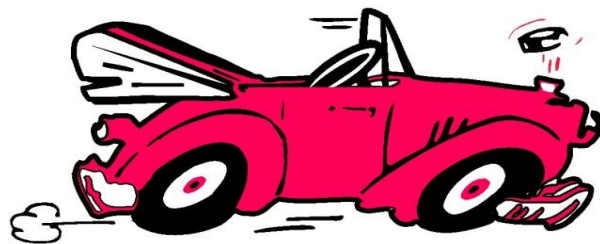

### 2015-2016 PROFILE

**The Community:** Perry is a small community located on the I-69 corridor in the southern central part of Shiawassee County. Perry is approximately 30 minutes from East Lansing, Flint, and Owosso. The Perry economy includes some agriculture enterprises and small manufacturing companies.

**The School:** Four year, comprehensive public high school grades 9-12  
Semester schedule with 6 class periods per day as of 14-15 school year  
511 student enrollment, 25 teachers  
143 seniors in the class of 2016  
Weighted AP and Dual Enrollment courses on a 5.0 grading scale-all other courses 4.0 scale  
Class rank computed based upon overall GPA in all subjects. All members of the class are included in the ranking list.  
Class rank is reported on school transcripts and is included in the college application process.  
Visitation Policy for colleges: All interested colleges must register with the high school counseling office for an acceptable visitation date. All visits occur during Excel time.  
The entire class of 2016 participated in MSTEP which included the ACT and ACT plus writing.

**Special Recognition:** The PHS Chorale received the rating of *Excellence in* the MSVMA District 5 Choral Festival.  
The PHS Band has earned multiple 1st division ratings at the MSBOA District 5 Marching Band and Band/Orchestra Festivals. 22% of the student enrollment participates in band.  
The PHS Science Olympiad team earned 2nd place at Regionals and advanced to State competition for the 3rd consecutive year.  
The PHS FFA Chapter has earned multiple state and national recognitions. Teams of Perry FFA students regularly win state leadership contests and represent Michigan at the national convention.  
The PHS Business Professionals of America has qualified students for state competition each year.  
PHS Girls' Basketball, Girls' Bowling and Boys Track teams won GLAC Championship.
